The fact is that occasionally there may not be enough parking for everyone and if so you will have to park (considerately) on the road.

Allotmenteering has understandably become increasingly popular during lockdown and we have a huge **waiting list.** So please make sure your plot is well tended - there are loads of people who are waiting for the chance to start allotment gardening. Also, we are now able to re-start regular *Plot Inspections* to make sure that plots are being used and maintained.

We have a revitalised **mowing rota** following an appeal for volunteers on our Facebook page but if you want to help there is always room for more! And if you're not able to volunteer, please remember to **keep the paths fully clear** of overhanging branches, stones and so on. If branches obstruct the mowers they will be pruned accordingly.
